Under 18s

Parish Players recognises that while younger members have the same rights as adult members to vote, audition and work backstage, we have a responsibility to ensure that the welfare of under 18 members is promoted to the best of our ability. We will therefore ensure that all members are aware of and signed up to our Safeguarding guidelines and inform
